The nomination process for election of Officers at the year 2024 Annual General Meeting has begun. Details of the nominating system and qualifications for eligibility to the Board of Directors and the various Committees are given below: <u>NOMINATING SYSTEM</u> Composition: The Nominating Committee shall consist of at least five (5) Members of the Credit Union., The members of the Nominating Committee shall be appointed annually by the Board of Directors at the first (1st) regular monthly meeting following the Annual General Meeting of the Credit Union and shall include at least one and no more than two directors. Main Functions: The Nominating Committee shall propose members for each vacancy on the Board of Directors, the Credit Committee and the Supervisory Committee for which an election is to be held. Detailed Duties: - The Nominating Committee shall cause notice to be given so that members may submit nominations to the Nominating Committee in the following manner: - Nominations shall be signed by two Eastern Credit Union Members – a Proposer and a Seconder in good standing. - Nominations must be received by the Nominating Committee on or before Friday 14th August 2026. Nominations received after this date will not be considered. - The Nominating Committee shall meet and consider the nominations without discrimination based on race, nationality or ethnic origin, colour, religion, sex or physical disability. - The Nominating Committee shall prepare a list of the nominees, which it recommends and shall deliver such list to the statutory meeting of the Board of Directors to be held in the month of August 2026. - The names of the candidates proposed by the Nominating Committee shall be made available to the Annual General Meeting. The complete list of nominees and their résumés shall be made available prior to and during the Annual General Meeting.	<u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u> The BOARD OF DIRECTORS is responsible for the overall management of the affairs and business of Eastern Credit Union. The CREDIT COMMITTEE is responsible for the consideration and approval of loans to members. The SUPERVISORY COMMITTEE is responsible for the examination of the affairs of the Credit Union. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u> Persons shall be eligible for election to the Board of Directors or the Credit Committee or the Supervisory Committee of Eastern Credit Union who fulfill the following requirements: - They must have contributed at least five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in shares at the end of the last financial year immediately preceding nomination (consistent with bye-law 4(b) (vii) and bye-laws 17(a) (i) to (iv). - Persons with litigation against ECU shall not be allowed to serve on the Board or Committees of ECU. - Officers from other credit unions shall not be allowed to serve on the Board or Committees of ECU. <i>(see asterisk below)</i> - Nominees are required to meet the fit and proper criteria under the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago Act, the Cooperative Societies Act Chap 81:03 and Regulations and Board policies as ratified per ECU Bye Law 15 (b) (vi) - A grace period of three years must elapse before a former employee of ECU becomes eligible to serve as an elected official. ❖ <i>According to Co-operative Societies Act, “Officer” includes the Chairman or President, secretary, treasurer, member of the board or other person empowered under the regulations or under the bye-laws of a society to give directions with regard to the business of that society.</i>	- He/ She should not be delinquent in his/her loan payments on the date on which his/her nomination application was signed. - Over the age of 18 years. - A citizen of Trinidad & Tobago lawfully admitted to permanent residency who is ordinarily a resident in Trinidad& Tobago - Not an employee of Eastern Credit Union - Not an undischarged bankrupt or declared bankrupt - Not of unsound mind and has not been convicted of: - An indictable offence - A criminal offence involving dishonesty in connection with the promotion or management of a corporation or co-operative. - An offence involving fraud NB. Nomination Forms shall be available at all Branches of Eastern Credit Union from 13th August 2026. These should be completed and returned no later than 4:00 pm on 14th August 2026.
